SUBSTRATE/USAGE GUIDELINES

GENERAL STATEMENT

It is the desire of BIBLICALSTORY that these materials and concepts would be used to further teach the church and further academic research. Thus, our general policy is that these materials may be utilized provided that appropriate credit is given to the originating author and BiblicalStory.org. The following points expand upon this philosophy for specific types of usage.

SPECIFIC USAGE STATEMENTS

- 1. GENERAL ACADEMIC USE: authors should use appropriate citation procedures in accordance with best practices of academic integrity.
- 2. LINKS: links to various documents on the BiblicalStory website (that is, links must be *to* the BiblicalStory website) may be placed on other sites, with attribution to <author>, BiblicalStory.org
- 3. COMMERCIAL USE: these materials may be used to create commercially available works, provided that a) proper attribution is given to <author>, BiblicalStory.org and b) said works are not mere republishing of the material but that the author has added significant value so that they are not a mere reproduction.
- 4. FILE REPOSTING: links may be posted on other sites to files located on BiblicalStory.org (and its affiliate links), but the actual files of documents obtained from BiblicalStory.org may not be posted on third party websites. This helps BiblicalStory.org understand usage statistics for these files as well as maintain control over the content itself. BiblicalStory may provide free of charge on request thumb drives containing all content for use in areas without internet access.
- 5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY: per the by-laws of BiblicalStory Incorporated, the intellectual property rights of various materials posted on BiblicalStory.org belong to the author of those materials, and the owners of these various documents may revoke this right at any time.
- 6. TRANSLATION: translators are free and encouraged to translate the materials on BiblicalStory.org, but BiblicalStory/the originator would retain intellectual property rights over any translation and may deny third party translators translation rights at any time. NOTE: BiblicalStory would be interested in making any translations done more broadly available, and asks that we be notified so we can evaluate them for suitability and broader distribution (request@biblicalstory.org).
